Where will I be based?

What hours would I be expected to do?

Saturdays, Hampshire Term–Time Only, 10.00–16.00

School Holidays, Monday–Friday, 10.00–16.00

Monday Evenings, Hampshire Term–Time Only (excluding Bank Holidays), 17.30–20.30

Staff will need to arrive at least 15 minutes before session start time. A timetable of available sessions will be provided to successful candidates.
