

Rainbow Corner

Rainbow Corner is a 6 bedded children's home providing overnight short breaks and day care for children and young people with additional needs, aged 3 to 19 years. Rainbow Corner has been adapted to meet the physical needs of the children that stay with us. This means that we can provide care for children and young people who have multiple and profound learning disabilities, including those on the Autistic Spectrum, those with complex medical health needs and physical disabilities.

Our service enables the child's family to have planned breaks from their carer role and provides opportunities for the children to have a day, night or weekend away from home to be with their peer group, making and sustaining friendships in a safe and caring environment.

What is a typical day at Rainbow Corner?

The day starts with getting the children up and ready for the day. This might be getting ready for school or for a fun filled weekend! The day will be spent doing activities with the children (at times planned trips out) and also completing mandatory tasks such as meal times, medication, personal hygiene (bathroom and showering) or tidying the home. If the children have been at school you may be part of the school pick up and drop off team. In the evenings you will be expected to help the children and young persons to wind down and get ready for bed.

Where will I be based?

You will be based at Rainbow Corner in Andover.

What hours would I be expected to do?

We provide 24/7 care to the children and young persons that use our service. As a member of the team you may be expected to work early mornings, late nights or stay overnight at the facility. Shifts may also fall on weekends and public holidays.

What training or experience will I need?

Full training will be provided to all successful applicants including Level 3 in Residential Care.
